



# Big White Rally Weekend December 6 Rally Test Day

## Volunteer Information

Thank you for supporting the growth of rallysport in the Okanagan! On Saturday most volunteers will be helping maintain stage security for rally teams from around BC to test and practice. You will be set up along the stage from approximately 10:00 - 17:00, so a big breakfast and a bagged lunch is recommended.

The mandatory safety meeting for all volunteers will be at the Gem Lake lot at 9:30 on Saturday morning. The rally teams will be doing recce at this time. The rally teams and cars will be at Gem Lake for Parc Expose from 8:00 - 8:30. If any volunteers would like to help prepare the stage early Saturday morning, contact Jennifer.

Volunteers will be divided into crews of 2-4 people, depending on conditions and turnout. Each crew will need a AWD vehicle, capable of traversing hills in winter conditions, that they will park at an assigned location within the stage. Most of these points are intersections or branches of the stage road, which must be secured before the rally traffic proceeds. Crews can use banner tape, pylons, or chairs to block the route; the volunteer vehicle can also be used to obstruct access to the stage from the branches.

Each crew will help track the rally car through the stage by radio, so that the test day can run efficiently and with the maximum stage time for the entrants. Calling the car as it passes the radio points is also the primary means for recognizing and locating a car that failed to negotiate the course successfully. A summary of the safety plan will be provided for volunteers, who are key elements in identifying and attending to injured persons in the unlikely event of an incident.

### What to bring:

Warm winter clothing  
Footwear for deep snow  
Helmet - to the regulation standards, in case of a ride along  
Sunglasses

Lunch & beverages  
Pocket knife  
Canvas chairs  
Head lamp / flashlight

HAM or frs radios (we need licensed HAM radio volunteers)  
Cell phone  
Video recorder / cameras!
