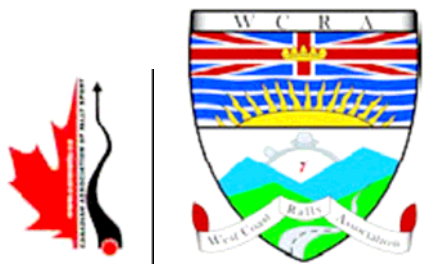


2007 Kamloops Novice Rally

June 3, 2007



This WCRA Novice Workshop is a morning classroom session and afternoon Time/Speed/Distance (TSD) Navigational Rally. The rally follows current BC Rally Regulations which can be found on <http://www.rallybc.com>. The rally will be about 150km with an odometer check of about 20 km and take place entirely in the Kamloops region of BC. Roads will be approximately 80% gravel / 20% paved. Instructions will be provided in both km and miles, but the official distances and calculations are based on the km figure.

TSD Novice Workshop -Kamloops

Supplementary Regulations:

- Are you interested in learning how to participate in rallying?
- Have you ever wondered what it would be like to drive your car on gravel roads?
- Do you need to polish up on your TSD skills?

If you don't know where to start, well ... do we have the workshop for you! WCRA Novice Rally Workshop will introduce you to the sport of TSD auto rallying. TSD = Time / Speed / Distance - three factors that are used to create a challenging auto event. This workshop will consist of both "on-road" and "classroom instructions. We will provide classroom instructions and theory about the sport. Experienced TSD rallyists will coach you on the finer skills of driving techniques and navigational calculations. Tricks and tips will be shared from the experts. We will provide instructions on what to expect at an event - everything from car inspection to route instructions. Then, we will answer all your questions.

We have also prepared an on-road TSD event for you to apply your new skills. You will be provided with feedback and your scores will be analyzed with you. Experts will be there to provide you with tips and explain what should and could have been done to better your scores.

This event will follow the 2007 BC Rally Regulations, which are available from Rally Pacific Motorsports. The rally runs on straight-forward instructions, and will be approximately 150 km (93 miles) in length with roads being approximately 80% gravel / 20% paved. Maximum distance between gas stops is 150 km (93 miles).

Required Equipment

- Fire extinguisher rated 5BC or 10BC
- Clipboard
- Pens & pencils
- Stopwatch or Digital watch
- Notepad or paper for notes
- Highlighters
- Battery powered Calculator (Not solar)
- 30 cm self-supporting safety triangle
- First Aid Kit (see www.rallybc.com for details and requirements)
- Tow Rope

Recommended Equipment

- Gravol or other Motion Sickness Medicine
- Toilet Paper (important when you are way in the bushes!)
- BCAA card if you have one

Minors – All participants under 19 must have two waiver forms signed or they will not be

This novice TSD workshop will have two classes, Novice and Experienced.

Novice: Neither team member having entered more than 3 TSD rallies before the current year,

and equipment limited to Calculator Class rules, which are “Non-programmable calculating devices which are not driven by a wheel, and accessory odometers”

Experienced: All other teams.
