

2007 WCRA Novice TSD Workshop #3

Supplementary Regulations:

The Third WCRA novice workshop will involve an evening classroom session followed by a short night time Gravel T.S.D rally to allow you to apply your knowledge for the class. This is part 3 of a 3 part series aimed at teaching the basics of T.S.D rallying. The rally follows current BC Rally Regulations which can be found at [http\\www.rallybc.com](http://www.rallybc.com), is held within Rally Pacific Motorsports Association TSD Rally Regulations and the C.A.R.S. General Competition rules. This rally will run on straight forward instructions provided during the class session. Instructions will be provided in both kilometres and miles but official measurements and scores will be in kilometres.

The on-road portion of the event will be approximately 320km long. Roads will be 30% paved 70% Gravel and take place entirely in the lower mainland. ****This rally will not have any gas stops, all competitors should fill before leaving, if you are unable to make the distance between stops on one tank of fuel please notify the organizer. Competitors will have a refuelling point and must bring a non-leaking gas can, which will be transported to the refuelling point for them.**

***** 09/04/07 Notice to competitors: Route and start times have changed, new distance between stops will be 150km.**

Required Equipment:

- Stopwatch or Digital watch
- Calculator, battery powered, NOT SOLAR
- Pencils and pens
- Highlighters (yellow highlighters do not work under red light)
- Map Light
- Clipboard
- Notepad or paper for taking notes
- 5bc or 10bc fire extinguisher
- First aid kit (see www.rallybc.com for full requirements)
- 30cm self supporting reflective triangle

Recommended Equipment:

- Tow Rope
- Gravol or motion sickness medicine
- Toilet paper (you'll know when u need it)
- BCAA card (if you have one)
- Spare batteries and a map light

Eligibility of vehicles

All Vehicles must:

- Registered to driver, navigator or have the owners written permission
- Have all items inside the car secure during event
- Have batteries securely fastened
- Meet street legal requirements
- Headlights
- Tail lights
- Brake lights
- Turn signals
- Reverse lights
- Horn
- Have any Auxiliary driving lights wired so they and the high beams can be disabled with one switch
